SENIOR CITIZEN SERVICES

AUGLAIZE COUNTY COUNCIL ON AGING PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

○ ***Outreach***

- personal contact, initial assessment, newsletters and speakers

○ ***Transportation Services***

- Provides In County transportation to medical appointments, grocery stores, banks, Adult Day Care.
- Out of County Transportation Only to medical appointments

○ ***Chore***

- Heavy cleaning, seasonal needs (lawn care/snow removal), and essential errands such as grocery shopping

○ ***Prescription Meals***

- Temporary, specialized home delivered meal program which provides two meals per day and a weekly supply of groceries
- Meals are prepared taking into consideration physician recommendations



SENIOR CITIZEN SERVICES

AUGLAIZE COUNTY COUNCIL ON AGING PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

○ ***Homemaker***

- Light house cleaning, bathrooms, laundry, dusting and sweeping—Service is limited.

○ ***Family Care Giving***

- Teaches practical techniques in basic care giving skills to in-home caregivers

○ ***Information and Referral***

- Information about and assistance with various programs

○ ***Socialization and Meal Site***

- Various social programs and daily meal site

○ ***Carrier Alert-in cooperation with Postal Service***

- Carriers watch for accumulation of mail which may indicate health issues



SENIOR CITIZEN SERVICES

AUGLAIZE COUNTY COUNCIL ON AGING PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

- ***Safe Return-in cooperation with the Alzheimer's Association***
 - Helps to identify, locate and return memory impaired individuals and their care givers through use of ID bracelets
- ***Vial of Life***
 - Storage of vital health history and medical information in Vials which are kept at residence—easily identifiable by emergency personnel
- ***Friendly Visitor***
 - Volunteers visit seniors. Designed to limit seniors isolation and loneliness
