

## Our Policies:

- All new clients are asked to complete a medical history form before they receive a massage.
- All medical history forms are 100% confidential to Licensed Massage Therapists at the New Bremen Massage Clinic, LLC.
- Our time, as well as yours, is very valuable. We will provide you with 24 hours notice if we cannot make the appointment, & we ask you to do the same.
- Walk-ins are accepted during all open hours, unless the appointment has been reserved by someone else.
- Our office hours are subject to change (we may have to run to bank, post office, etc.) Payment is expected on the same day as your appointment.
- Our massage therapists are part of the medical profession. Clients with sexual expectations will be asked to leave.
- We do accept workman's compensation injuries. A doctor's prescription is required.
- We do accept insurance, but your insurance company may not cover massage therapy. A doctor's prescription is required.
- We discourage home visits, unless you are physically unable to come to our clinic.
